High School Classes for 8th - 12th Graders (2006 - 07 school year)

Battle Ground School District strives to offer the best possible academic opportunities for our high school students to graduate. We realize that transportation may be difficult for some students. Special grant funding for high school summer school transportation has been secured and will be available from common sites throughout the district to assist your child in attending the Intensive Reading Workshop, Intensive Math Workshop, or Intervention Algebra/Geometry class listed below as well as the 2-week WASL Prep classes. To enable us to have this set up in advance, please register your child by June 22. You will be contacted by Friday, July 6 of these pick-up/drop-off points.

High School Academics

For 8th graders entering high school in Fall of 2007 or current 9th, 10th & 11th graders! Battle Ground Public School's Community Education and district high schools are teaming up to offer summer classes to help students be more successful in high school-level classes. Intensive Reading Workshop 530001
Improve your ability to read for meaning and to approach literature with increased enjoyment and confidence. Class will include the following units: word analysis and decoding skills, oral reading fluency, base vocabulary growth, spelling, and study skills. Credit for successful completion of this class is a .5 elective. Fee: \$175

Struggling with Algebra or Geometry during the school year? Take this Intervention Algebra/Geometry class to brush up on these math skills and be more successful or maybe even "ace" your class in the fall. Successful completion of this class will result in .5 math credit. Fee: \$175

WASL retakes: 10th & 11th grade students (in the 2006-07 school year) will be eligible to retake the WASL test at Battle Ground High School this August. Students will need to preregister with the state June 8th to July 8th either online at <http://www.k12.wa.us/waslregistration> or by calling 1-866-400-WASL (9275). All students will need photo ID for entry the day of the tests. Tentative dates for retakes are as follows: Reading is Monday, August 6th, Math is Tuesday, August 7th, and Writing: Expository is Wednesday, August 8th. Additional information is forthcoming; however, please note these important August dates when planning your summer activities.

Important Information!

- Standards of conduct for all students enrolled in the above-mentioned summer school classes are the same as described in the Battle Ground High School and Prairie High School Student Handbooks. Handbooks are available upon request from our office.
- Call Community Education, 885-6584, for a High School Credit Classes registration form (required). For fee-based classes - A class fee of \$175 must be prepaid to the Community Education office located at 104 West Main Street, Battle Ground; or mail to Community Education, PO Box 200, Battle Ground, WA, 98604-0200 before the class begins. Students will not be allowed into class without prior payment. Refunds are not available after class starts.
- Attendance is important due to the intensity and condensed time frame of these summer classes. Failure to meet the required time in class due to absences and tardies will result in an automatic 'F' and forfeiture of the class fee in the fee-based classes.

For 10th, 11th & 12th grade students (in the 2006-07 school year and graduating classes of 2008 & 2009) These classes start two weeks before the WASL retake and are for all students that did not pass the WASL, especially for students who were close to passing. WASL test results will be mailed to parents in early June; please wait until receiving the results to determine if these classes are needed or appropriate. Students taking the following classes will practice math, reading, or writing WASL questions, review specific vocabulary, and cover test taking strategies in preparation for their WASL retake.
