
Academic Summer School for 8th Graders

entering 9th Grade for the 2006 - 07 school year

For 8th graders! (entering high school in Fall of 2006) Battle Ground Public School's Community Education Program and district high schools are teaming up to offer classes during the summer to prepare students to retest for reading and math placement in their freshman year while earning an elective credit. Each class equals 1/2 credit, which is the same as one semester class. Please check with either the BGHS Counseling Center at 885-6556 or the PHS Counseling Center at 885-5002 for class information. Call Community Education, 885-6584, for a High School Credit Class registration form (if not attached). **Classes are \$175 each and must be prepaid before the class starts.**

8th Grade Academy

These classes are for students scoring below the benchmarks in reading and/or math.

Intensive Reading Workshop

Improve your ability to read for meaning and to approach literature with increased enjoyment and confidence. Class will include the following units: word analysis and decoding skills, oral reading fluency, base vocabulary growth, spelling, and study skills. This class is .5 elective credit.

Improve your basic skills in math and practical application through repetition and guided practice. Special assistance will be given to help students with problem solving strategies. This class is .5 elective credit.

Refunds are not available after class starts.**
- Attendance is important due to the intensity and condensed time frame of the class. Failure to meet the required time in class due to absences and tardies will result in an automatic 'F' and forfeiture of the class fee.
