Credit Recovery Options

8th - 12th grade students (2005-06 school year) Prairie and Battle Ground High Schools have been surveyed and the results indicate insufficient interest to be able to pay an instructor to offer summer classes. Options available for those students who are meeting benchmarks but have been unsuccessful in receiving the credits they need are as follows:
